THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS ROADS, SOUTH LAKELAND AREA) (APPLEBY HORSE FAIR) (TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 20><

Statement of Reasons

The Appleby Horse Fair occurs annually in June attracting many additional visitors to Appleby and the surrounding area. Following the introduction of temporary traffic regulation orders in 2010 covering the duration of the Fair it is proposed to introduce a permanent traffic regulation order. The order is proposed to minimise the impact of the extra Appleby Fair traffic on the main southern approach road through South Lakeland to Appleby. This is the A683 from Kirkby Lonsdale through Sedbergh to the District boundary at Rawthey Bridge.

The Appleby Fair Order for South Lakeland covers the A683 from Kirkby Lonsdale through Sedbergh to the Eden / South Lakeland district boundary including all the side roads and laybys off the A683 and some off the A684. The order comprises road closures, one-way traffic and No Waiting At Any Time (double yellow lines) restrictions.

The order would come into force annually between 1 April and 30 June to cover the Appleby Horse Fair. All restrictions would be in force "as and when signs are displayed".
