**STATEMENT OF REASONS**

Cumbria County Council considers that it is expedient to propose to make the above Order for the following reasons: -

- (a) For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, or
- (b) For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).

The proposals, as shown on the plans, are as follows: -

**BUSHER WALK SERVICE ROAD PROPOSED TRAFFIC SAFETY MEASURES**

Currently, mainly operational vehicles, park on Busher Walk Service Road. This road is used for access for Cumbria Fire and Rescue Service car parking, Cumbria County Council parking and Police Parking. It is felt to be a health and safety risk for police responding to a call out as they may meet oncoming vehicles. Also due to the width of the road, the vehicles parking in the area surrounding the police station can hinder traffic movement in this area.

To avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising it is proposed to implement a One-Way traffic flow along the Busher Walk Service Road, Kendal, from the southern junction with Busher Walk, around the Police Station in an anti-clockwise direction, for its entirety, to the northern junction with Busher Walk. Aiming to make traffic flow easier and safer.

In addition it is proposed to install double yellow lines indicating "No Waiting At Any Time" along sections of Busher Walk Service Road, Kendal, from the southern junction with Busher Walk, around the Police Station. The aim is to help with service vehicular movements, improve visibility and provide a passing place for vehicles on that section of Busher Walk Service Road.

The County Council of Cumbria in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 19, 32, 35, 35A, 38, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 64 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on >< and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, South Lakeland Area) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) (Order 2002) (Busher Walk Service Road, Kendal) Variation Order 20><
2. For the purposes of this Order the expression “the 2002 Order” shall mean The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, South Lakeland Area) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) Order 2002
3. The 2002 Order shall have effect as though: -
  - (a) **The following entries were added to “Schedule 52, Part 1, Kendal – No Waiting At any Time”:-**

Busher Walk Service Road Unnamed road between U684 Busher Walk (East - West) to junction with Busher Walk (North – South)	NWAAT	West	From it’s junction with U684 Busher Walk (East - West) for a distance of 74.5m in a northerly direction.

(b) The following entry was added to “Schedule 109, Part 1, Kendal – One Way Traffic”: -

4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

1. The Cumbria County Council hereby give notice that it proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 19, 32, 35, 35A, 38, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The effect of the proposed Order will be to: -
  - (a) Introduce a One-Way traffic restriction along the Busher Walk Service Road, Kendal, from the southern junction with Busher Walk, around the Police Station in generally northerly then westerly (anti-clockwise) direction, for its entirety; and
  - (b) Introduce “No Waiting At Any Time”, ie double yellow line restrictions along both sides of Busher Walk Service Road, Kendal, from the southern junction with Busher Walk, around the Police Station.
