Re: Proposed Residents Parking Bays on Soutergate

As your local County Councillor I am writing to you with regards to parking issues in the above areas. I would like to make sure that all residents have the opportunity to put their views forward whilst highlighting any areas of concern you may have.

We are looking to consult with members of the community regarding the proposed residents parking bays on the following street:

- **Soutergate** - Residents have raised issues with parking over a number of years. Councillor James Airey met with residents to discuss possible options to improve parking on Soutergate. The demand on The Gill is already high and it isn't appropriate to add Soutergate to the existing zone. Highways Officers have looked at the existing restrictions and it is possible to reduce the double yellow lines to allow more flexibility for parking. It is proposed to extend the existing parking space and make it parking for Permit Holders Only. Permits would be made available to residents of Soutergate only. It is also possible to lessen the double yellow lines to single yellow lines (No Waiting 8am – 6pm) allowing parking on evenings. This will allow more flexible parking arrangements for residents.

A plan of this area is enclosed over the page along with a feedback sheet where you can give details of any issues you may have with the proposals as well as possible solutions. I would be grateful if you could complete this and return it to us by **3rd February 2012**.

If you prefer to discuss this in person, you are welcome to come along to a Community Drop In session from **3.30pm – 6:30pm on Tuesday 24th January at the Ulverston Parish Centre, Church Walk**.
